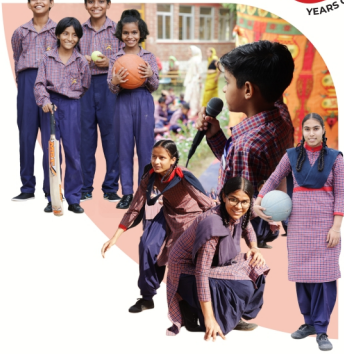

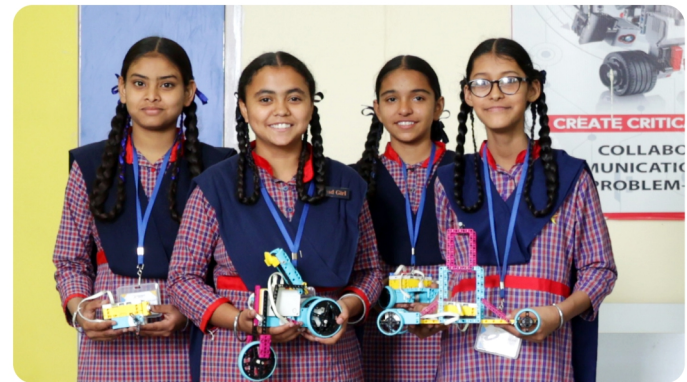

Satya Bharti Schools

Satya Bharti Schools, the flagship initiative of the Bharti Airtel Foundation, has been providing free, quality education since 2006, with a special focus on the girl child. The schools offer a dynamic learning environment that integrates digital tools, project-based learning, co-curricular activities, and innovative teaching methods. Students also receive essential resources, including books, uniforms, shoes, and nutritious mid-day meals.

Additionally, the schools enhance the learning experience and support the holistic development of students through vibrant teaching materials, digital classrooms, robotics labs, structured career awareness initiatives, a strong focus on sports, and pre-vocational education from middle school onwards, equipping students with essential life and career skills.

Together, these initiatives strengthen school operations and foster both academic and personal development, empowering students to become responsible, self-reliant, and employable citizens of the country.



Advancing Foundational Learning in India

Bharti Airtel Foundation and the Gates Foundation are working together to strengthen Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) in government schools across Odisha and Madhya Pradesh. Focused on helping children build essential reading and numeracy skills that enable them to succeed in school and beyond, this initiative will impact over 50 lakhs government school students across multiple states over the next four years.

Quality Support Program

Launched in 2013, the Quality Support Program (QSP) strengthens government schools by transforming them into happy, holistic, and sustainable learning institutions. The program integrates life skills, employability skills, values-based education, and student-centric academic practices to enhance the quality, relevance, and sustainability of school education. Drawing inspiration from the successful practices of Satya Bharti Schools, QSP fosters leadership, critical thinking, communication, and other 21st-century competencies through innovative approaches and appropriate technology integration. Its structured, vision-driven framework engages students, teachers, parents, and school leaders over three to five years, enabling schools to become self-sustaining centers of excellence. Through student-led clubs that encourage entrepreneurship and creativity, and teacher-led initiatives that drive continuous school improvement, QSP equips learners with the skills, confidence, and mindset needed to thrive in a rapidly changing world.



Quality Support Program (QSP) State Partnerships

To further amplify the impact of the Quality Support Program (QSP), the Foundation collaborates with state education departments through QSP State Partnerships. The core objective is to provide technical support and strengthen systemic capacity, enabling district and block-level interventions in government schools. Aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the program seeks to enhance the overall schooling experience by focusing on life skills development for students and professional growth for educators.

TheTeacherApp

Marking a significant digital leap in its journey, the Foundation launched TheTeacherApp in November 2024. This dynamic platform empowers India's teachers with high-quality content, practical and AI-enabled tools to enhance learning outcomes—empowering teachers today with the skills of tomorrow, at their pace, at their place, at their path, and all this completely free-for-life.

Built on two decades of grassroots insights, TheTeacherApp creates an inclusive space where teachers can learn, engage, and lead change in classrooms across the country. With partnerships already underway in several states and collaboration with NITI Aayog to reach Aspirational Districts, TheTeacherApp is emerging as a comprehensive platform to elevate teaching and learning experiences by offering comprehensive learning resources, an intuitive user-centric design, and interactive features accessible across both web and mobile platforms.



Higher Education and Scholarships



Bharti Airtel Foundation has partnered with prestigious academic institutions to advance higher education through access, opportunities and excellence. Its institutional alliances span a wide range of disciplines, reflecting a comprehensive vision for transforming India's educational landscape. These include the establishment of the Bharti School of Telecommunication Technology and Management at IIT Delhi, the Bharti Centre for Communication at IIT Bombay, and the Bharti Institute of Public Policy at the Indian School of Business (ISB), Mohali. To create an environment where learning and innovation can flourish, the Foundation has supported in strengthening of world-class campus infrastructure at institutions such as Plaksha University (Mohali), Anant National University (Ahmedabad), Chanakya University (Bengaluru), and the School of Ultimate Leadership (Gandhinagar).

Bharti Airtel Scholarship

Launched in 2024, the Bharti Airtel Scholarship supports deserving students from diverse socio-economic backgrounds pursuing undergraduate engineering and integrated technology programs at the top 50 NIRF-ranked engineering institutions in India. With a preference for female students, the Foundation aims to expand access to future-ready education and nurture the next generation of technology leaders.

The program eliminates financial barriers to quality education by covering 100% of annual academic expenses, including tuition, hostel, and mess fees. In addition, all selected students receive a complimentary laptop during their first year to support their academic journey. Upon successful graduation and securing gainful employment, all Bharti Scholars voluntarily commit to supporting the education of at least one student throughout their lifetime. This commitment fosters a culture of giving back, ensuring the continued empowerment of future generations through education and community support.

In addition, the Foundation also supports students of other institutions through need-based scholarships, with a special focus on girl students.
