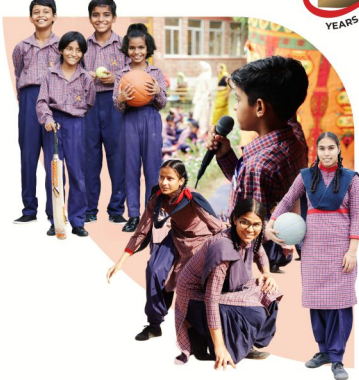

Satya Bharti Schools

The Satya Bharti School Program, launched in 2006, is the flagship initiative of the Bharti Airtel Foundation. Its core mission is to provide free, quality education while promoting the holistic development of students, with a special focus on the girl child. The program offers a dynamic learning environment that integrates digital tools, project-based learning, co-curricular activities, and innovative teaching methods. Students also receive essential resources, including books, uniforms, shoes, and nutritious mid-day meals.

Additionally, the program enhances the learning experience through vibrant teaching materials, digital classrooms, and robotics labs to ensure future readiness.

Together, these initiatives strengthen school operations and foster both academic and personal development, empowering students to become responsible, self-reliant, and employable citizens of the country.



Quality Support Program (QSP)

Launched in 2013, the Quality Support Program strengthens government schools to create happy, holistic learning spaces over three to five years. It integrates core life skills, learner readiness, and student-centric practices within the schooling ecosystem, focusing on quality, consistency, and sustainability. Inspired by the best practices of Satya Bharti Schools, the program nurtures leadership, communication, and 21st-century skills through co-scholastic and innovative activities. Its structured, vision-driven framework engages students, parents, communities, and school leadership to co-create self-sustaining learning environments, complementing government priorities and driving system-wide improvement. Key initiatives include fostering critical thinking, problem-solving, and communication skills; encouraging innovation and entrepreneurship through student led clubs; and empowering student leaders to create meaningful change within their schools.



Quality Support Program (QSP) State Partnerships

To further amplify the impact of the Quality Support Program (QSP), the Foundation collaborates with state education departments through QSP State Partnerships. The core objective is to provide technical support and strengthen systemic capacity, enabling district and block-level interventions in government schools. Aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the program seeks to enhance the overall schooling experience by focusing on life skills development for students and professional growth for educators.

TheTeacherApp

Marking a significant digital leap in its journey, the Foundation launched TheTeacherApp in November 2024, inaugurated by the Hon'ble Union Minister of Education, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan. This dynamic platform empowers India's teachers with high-quality content and practical tools to enhance learning outcomes—empowering teachers today with the skills of tomorrow, at their pace, at their place, at their path, and all this free for life.

Built on two decades of grassroots insights, TheTeacherApp creates an inclusive space where teachers can learn, engage, and lead change in classrooms across the country. With partnerships already underway in several states and collaboration with NITI Aayog to reach Aspirational Districts, the platform is emerging as the ultimate app to elevate teaching and learning experiences by offering comprehensive learning resources, an intuitive user-centric design, and interactive features accessible across web and mobile platforms.





Higher Education and Scholarships

Bharti Airtel Foundation has partnered with some of India's leading institutions, such as IIT Delhi, IIT Bombay, Indian School of Business, Plaksha University, Chanakya University, Anant National University, School of Ultimate Leadership, and J.C. Bose University of Science and Technology, to advance higher education through both access and excellence. This commitment includes offering scholarships to deserving students and strengthening world-class campus infrastructure.

With a vision to create opportunities for young individuals from disadvantaged socio-economic backgrounds and support them in becoming future technology leaders, the Bharti Airtel Scholarship was launched in 2024. The program enables students to pursue tech-based engineering courses at the undergraduate or integrated level in India's top 50 NIRF-ranked engineering institutes. Covering tuition, accommodation, meals, and a laptop, the scholarship allows students to focus on learning and innovation. Beyond financial aid, the program fosters a culture of giving back. Upon successful graduation and subsequent gainful employment, Bharti Scholars undertake to voluntarily support at least one student at the school or college level on a continuous basis, ensuring the sustained empowerment of future generations through education.
